

Old Market Violations

Old Market Association has been receiving complaints on the following violations within the community. Scan the QR Code with your phone to pull up the specific Ordinance from the City of Omaha.

Amplifiers used by Performers: Please play UNPLUGGED!

According to the *Code of Ordinances City of Omaha Noise Regulations*
Section 17-3. – Volume Control:



No person shall play, use, operate or permit to be played, used or operated, any radio, tape recorder, cassette player, CD player, or other machine or device for reproducing sound, if it is located in or on:

- (1) Any public property unless the volume of amplified sound shall be so controlled that it will not be audible for a distance in excess of one hundred (100) feet from the source and so that the volume is not unreasonably great and the noise, or a nuisance to persons within the area of audibility; or
 - (2) Residential property that it will not be audible in any adjoining unit.

Street Vendors

Vendor should not be permanent or regular nor should they compete directly with permanent businesses that occupy owned or leased space in the Old Market. Do not block the sidewalks as they are very narrow in Old Market! You must have the following appropriate licenses displayed as listed in the *Peddler Permit*:

- City of Omaha Municode – Peddler Permit
- Nebraska Sales Tax Permit
- Public Property Bond in the amount of \$10,000
- Certificate of Liability Insurance in the amount of \$500,000
- Permission from the property owner (*including the sidewalk area*)
- Copy of Health Department Permit (*if applicable*)



Bikes, Rollerblades & Skateboards

Please stay off the sidewalk!

According to the *Code of Ordinances City of Omaha Traffic Rules:*

Sec. 36-148: Roller-skating, skateboarding, and bicycling.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, use, operate, race, or propel a skateboard or bicycle on the public sidewalks of the downtown business district and the public sidewalks of the Old Market.



Scooters

- No Sidewalk Riding
- Stay Outside No-Ride Zones including the Old Market brick streets
- Must be 18 years old
- Operating Hours: 5am to 10:30pm



According to the *Code of Ordinances City of Omaha Traffic Rules: Sec. 36-146 – Motorized Scooter Operation Violation.*
